Pacific Repertory Theatre to present Apollo Dukakis at the Outdoor Forest Theater in a live tribute to Olympia Dukakis

CARMEL, CA (September 15, 2022) Pacific Repertory Theatre (PacRep) is proud to announce a one-night-only live fundraising event called **Remembering Olympia**. The evening will feature actor Apollo Dukakis in this intimate tribute to his sister, Academy Award-winning actress Olympia Dukakis, who died in 2021 at the age of 89.

This special one-night-only event will be presented at 7:00 pm on Monday, October 3, 2022, at Carmel's historic Outdoor Forest Theater, located at the corner of Mountain View Avenue and Santa Rita Street in downtown Carmel-by-the-Sea. Tickets range in price from \$22 to \$52 and are available now [on PacRep's website](#). VIP ticketholders may attend a post-show meet and greet wine reception with Apollo Dukakis.

In this tribute and celebration of Ms. Dukakis' life and career, the evening will start with a montage of rare photos of some of her stage work, plus glimpses of family and friends. This will be followed by a 40-minute, two-person, one-act play, written by and starring Apollo Dukakis, called **You And Me**, featuring actress Kandis Chappell. **You And Me** is a play Mr. Dukakis wrote about his relationship with his famous sister, Olympia Dukakis.

Following **You And Me** will be a montage of scenes from Ms. Dukakis' films. The evening will conclude with an audience Question & Answer session, monitored by PacRep Alumnus John Farmanesh-Bocca.

Prior to bringing **Remembering Olympia** to Carmel, Mr. Dukakis has performed this unique evening at the Lunt/Fontanne Arts Center in Milwaukee, the Los Angeles Greek Film Festival in Hollywood, and most recently at the North Coast Repertory Theatre near San Diego.
